

The Pukekohe Club makes its debut with Alan Gibbons / Shaun Pennell travelling up the southern motorway in search for some glory. Hikurangi's Ken Fitness has paired up with Mike Bradshaw from Onehunga and Districts.

Also venturing down from the winterless north are Coopers Beach's Trevor Smith with Kerikeri's Kevin Williams. Also from Kerikeri David Hood brings with him Kaitiia Combined's Barry Allison. New comers are Opononi's Sean and Mike Fitzgerald along with Arapohue's Sandy Foy and Kevin Gainfort from Thames Coast

Onerahi's John Dunn returns for his fourth tournament accompanied by Neil Connell Hillsbro's Rory Sedon steps in the helm with fellow club mate Ciaran McElvanna after Shane Gibson was unable to play, Shane tells the Bee Express he'll be back next year.

Local Birkenhead Club team Nigel Drew / Mark Rumble playing pairs for the first time since their Junior days. The Scott Mouton / Peter Nathan combination could be worth a watching, untried combination with ability to claim some scalps. Gary Stevens / Mike Hitchcock will be hoping to "mow" through the field chasing some cash. Birkenhead's President Keith Burgess has grabbed Carlton Cornwall's Russell Hocking. While Carlton Cornwall's Terry O'Connor and freshly crowned National Pairs Champion Petar Sain would be expected to feature in the top four mix.

Glenfield player Jimmy Gifford, now resident in "The Tron", will lead for Birkenhead's Merv Garred. Neighbouring club Northcote show their presence on the greens with the pairing of Mike Haggart / John Hindmarch along with the Glenfield club and the Brian Nolan / Gary Helming, and David Gear / Tom Campbell combinations. Glenfield's Bruce Baker brings with him Ryman Healthcare Men's Open Pairs virgin Doug Campbell. Mairangi Bay is represented by Gary Seddon / Glenn Stratford and Gary Banks has Pt Chev's John Petelo with him.
